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The Wellbeing in Schools – a European Strength in the future

Vaslui County School Inspectorate announces the organisation of the International Seminar on the theme of „The school's well being insurance-a strengths-based approach”, in the frame of the LLP/Comenius Regio regional partnership entitled “Wellbeing in New Educational Research”, the 22nd of May 2013, 14.00 hours, at the „Ion Mincu” Highschool Vaslui.

In the frame of the Lifelong Learning Programme, financed by the European Commission through the National Agency for Community Programmes in the field of Education and Professional Training, Vaslui County School Inspectorate got a grant for the project “Wellbeing in New Educational Research”.

The project has as partners Regione Umbria, Italia and other schools and associations from the same region. As local partners, in the project are involved: Prefect Institution-Vaslui County, Vaslui County Centre of Resources and Educational Assistance, „Ion Mincu” Highschool Vaslui and the Youth Association „Ion Mincu Mileniul III” Vaslui.

The Project is implemented during 24 months, between August 2011 – July 2013 and it is financed with 26.500 Euro by the European Commission and the National Agency for Community Programmes in the field of Education and Professional Training prin Programul Lifelong Learning and cofinanced by the Prefect Institution-Vaslui County with 2500 Euro and the Vaslui County School Inspectorate with 1000 Euro.

In the respect of the Lisbon Agenda objectives and in the 2020 Strategy perspective, this Comenius Regio Partnership aims to strength the links between European educational systems(Italian and Romanian) for a healthier, friendly and non discriminatory school environment in both countries. This seminar, the last in a series of 6, in which 3 organised in Italy, wants to show how and why the wellbeing of all actors involved in and in the relationship with the school(students, teachers, parents, local authorities), reflected in a friendly, inclusive educational environment, is a strength in attracting the young generation to a lifelong learning process, diminishing the school failure and the nonparticipation to education.

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
