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## **All-Inclusive School – A School for All and Everybody**

Vaslui County School Inspectorate organised the 2<sup>nd</sup> transnational project meeting in the frame of the project “All-Inclusive School”, implemented in the Erasmus+ Programme 2014-2020, between 1<sup>st</sup> of October 2018 – 31<sup>st</sup> of December 2020.

The project is coordinated by IRECOOP Emilia Romagna(Bologna, Italy), in partnership with institutions from Belgium(University College of Leuven-Limburg), Germany(Landkreis Kassel), Italy(Archillabò, Technical Institute “I. Calvi”),Spain(Colegio Huerta Santa Ana) and Romania(Vaslui County School Inspectorate, Vaslui County Centre of Resources and Psycho-pedagogical Assistance).

The general objective of the project is to strengthen the methodological and digital skills of teachers and educators to foster the inclusion of students with mild intellectual disabilities (DSM-5) by creating innovative technological results to be used by teachers / educators to better manage diversity and promoting the integration of pupils with disabilities into the classroom.

The project also intends to get three final products, intellectual outputs to support the teachers working with SEN students integrated in main stream schools: a research-analysis study on the skills and practices of teachers working with pupils with SEN integrated in main stream schools; practical guide for teachers; innovative learning collaborative web application for students and teachers.

During the second transnational project meeting, organised in Vaslui, Romania, by the Vaslui County School Inspectorate and Vaslui County Centre of Resources and Psycho-pedagogical Assistance, the 22 members of the partners teams made a stage evaluation of the project and presented the partial results. They also established the next steps on project’s implementation and Intellectual Outputs realisation and the best modalities of involving local schools as associated partners. The 3<sup>rd</sup> transnational project meeting will take place in October 2019, in Belgium.

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
